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HIGHLIGHTS

The comparisons shown in this report are from Fall 1999 to Fall 2003.

University Level

- **Enrollment** – UTPA continues to grow at a fast pace showing a 27% increase in the past 5 years.
- **Semester Credit Hours (SCH)** – Throughout the University semester credit hours continue to increase, especially at the doctoral level which saw a 57% increase in the past 5 years.
- **Retention** – Although retention has increased throughout the University, the increase has been erratic.
- **Degrees Awarded** – The number of degrees awarded throughout the University continues to increase in relation to overall enrollment with the greatest percentage increase being at the doctoral level. Even though the doctoral level continues to increase, attention needs to be paid to this area in order for UTPA to meet its goal of becoming classified as a Doctoral/Research University Intensive.

College Level

- **College of Arts & Humanities**
 - **Bachelor's**
 - **Enrollment** – Largest increase in enrollment of the six colleges. The only department of concern in this College is Latin American Studies with very low numbers and a decrease in enrollment.
 - **SCH** – Increase throughout except for Interdisciplinary Studies.
 - **Retention** – Increased, but has been erratic.
 - **Degrees Awarded** – Overall increase in degrees awarded except in the Art Department which had the largest increase in enrollment but a decline in degrees awarded. Latin American Studies had very few degrees awarded over the last 5 years.
 - **Master's**
 - **Enrollment** – Overall increase, but three of its departments show a small decline.
 - **SCH** – Most of the departments in this college continue to grow in SCH, especially History & Philosophy and Music. On the other hand, Communications has seen a large decrease in the last 5 years.
 - **Degrees Awarded** – Every department has had a decrease except for Art and Modern Literature and even in these departments the numbers of degrees awarded are very few.
- **College of Business Administration**
 - **Bachelor's**
 - **Enrollment** – There has been an overall increase in enrollment. Accounting/Business Law is the only department that is not growing and remains the same after 5 years.
 - **SCH** – Increase throughout.

- **Retention** – Overall it has been up but it has been consistently up only in Management/Marketing.
 - **Degrees Awarded** – Large drop in degrees awarded in the Department of Accounting/Business Law.
 - **Master’s**
 - **Enrollment** – Overall the enrollment is down in the Master’s program. Only College to have a decrease in enrollment over the past 5 years.
 - **SCH** – A large decrease in this College overall, except in the department of Accounting/Business Law. Only College to have a decrease in SCH.
 - **Degrees Awarded** – A spike in degrees awarded occurred in 2001, but has declined nearly back to its starting point 5 years ago.
 - **Doctoral**
 - **Enrollment** – Continued increase in enrollment.
 - **SCH** – Overall increase with a large increase in Quantitative Methods and a large decrease in Accounting/Business Law.
 - **Degrees Awarded** – An overall increase but not a steady increase.
- **College of Education**
 - **Bachelor’s**
 - **Enrollment** – Increase in enrollment.
 - **SCH** – Overall increase, except the Departments of Educational Psychology and Health & Kinesiology were down.
 - **Retention** – Steady and increasing.
 - **Degrees Awarded** – Small increase in the degrees awarded. Concern with the numbers not growing in Interdisciplinary Studies, since the need for elementary education teachers continues to grow in South Texas.
 - **Master’s**
 - **Enrollment** –Health & Kinesiology had a very large increase.
 - **SCH** – Increase in every department except Educational Psychology which remained the same.
 - **Degrees Awarded** – Overall increase but concern that degrees awarded in Educational Leadership has declined as this could not only lead to a problem with the doctoral programs but for the training of professionals in education in South Texas.
 - **Doctoral**
 - **Enrollment** – Continues to increase but not steady.
 - **SCH** – The increase is very high.
 - **Degrees Awarded** – No increase. Although enrollment continues to grow, if the number of degrees awarded does not increase UTPA will have difficulty reaching its goal of “becoming the doctoral research University in South Texas” as well as “becoming a state leader in the population and production of public school teachers.”

- **College of Health & Human Services**
 - **Bachelor's**
 - **Enrollment** – Overall the College continues to grow with the biggest increase in Communication Disorders and the biggest decrease in Occupational Therapy. The Department of Cooperative Pharmacy began in Fall 2003.
 - **SCH** – Overall increase except in HRP.
 - **Retention** – Overall increase but erratic.
 - **Degrees Awarded** – Overall Increase except in Nursing.
 - **Master's**
 - **Enrollment** – Very large increase overall.
 - **SCH** – Large increase except in Nursing which also continued to increase but well below the other departments.
 - **Degrees Awarded** – Increase in all degrees awarded except for Communication Disorders.

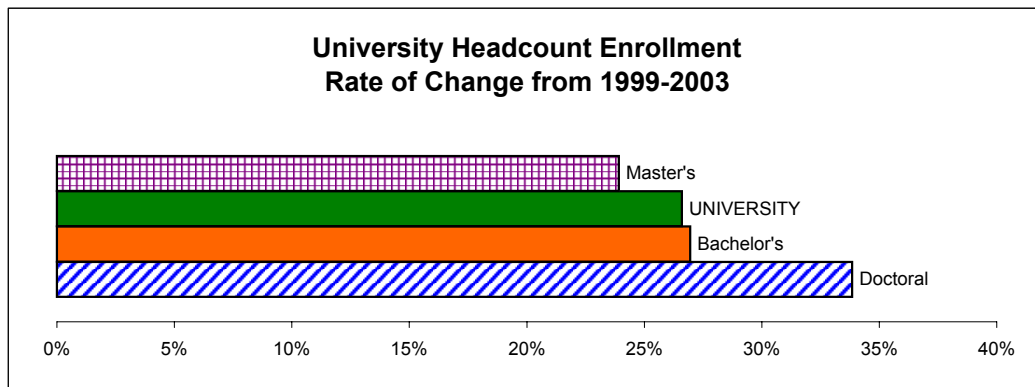
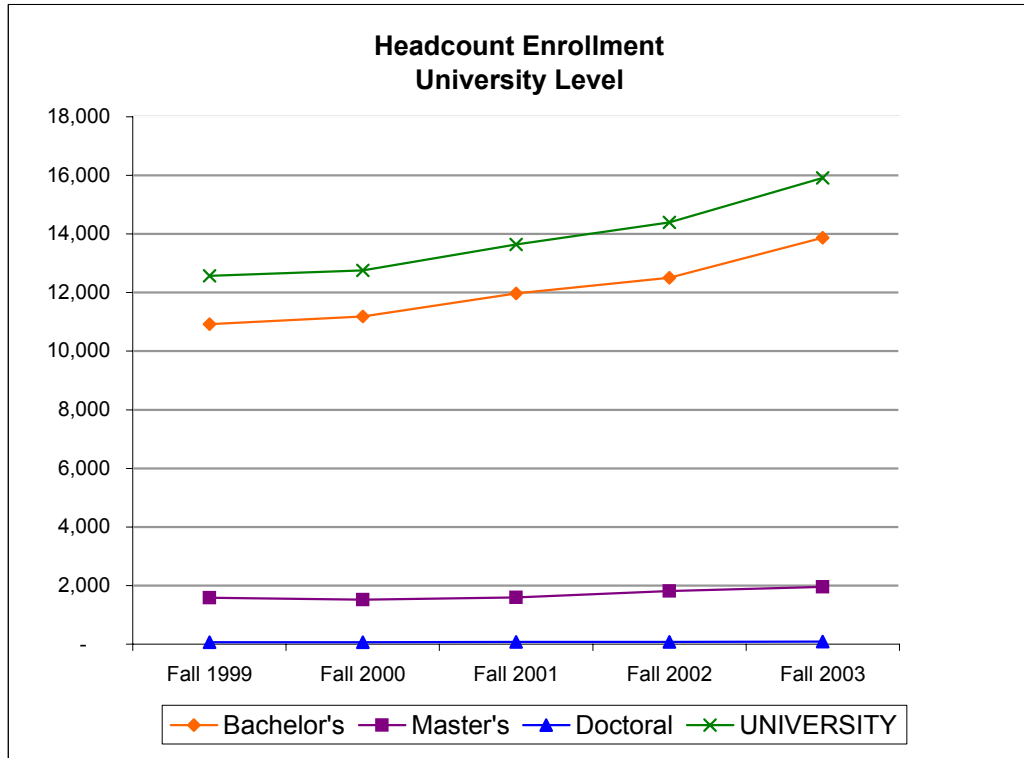
- **College of Science & Engineering**
 - **Bachelor's**
 - **Enrollment** – Overall increase especially in Chemistry and Physics/Geology. Decrease in Mathematics and Pre-Engineering.
 - **SCH** – Overall increase except in Computer Science.
 - **Retention** – Continues to increase except in Mathematics and Pre-Engineering.
 - **Degrees Awarded** – Overall increase except in Mathematics. Concern with overall trend in Mathematics and not being able to meet the needs of the public schools with qualified math teachers.
 - **Master's**
 - **Enrollment** – Very large increase in the engineering specialties. Decrease in Biology.
 - **SCH** – Large increase here as well except in Biology.
 - **Degrees Awarded** – No increase in degrees awarded in Biology and Math.

- **College of Social & Behavioral Sciences**
 - **Bachelor's**
 - **Enrollment** – Overall increase except in Political Science.
 - **SCH** – Biggest increase in Criminal Justice.
 - **Retention** – Continues to increase but erratic.
 - **Degrees Awarded** – Overall increase except in Criminal Justice and Sociology.

- **Master's**
 - **Enrollment** – Increase in all departments.
 - **SCH** – Overall increase except for a decrease in Criminal Justice.
 - **Degrees Awarded** – Increase in all departments except Criminal Justice.

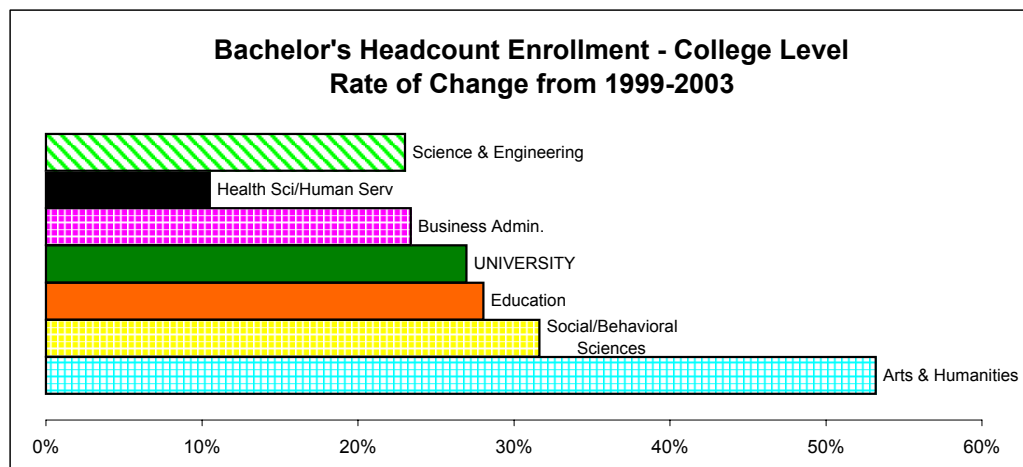
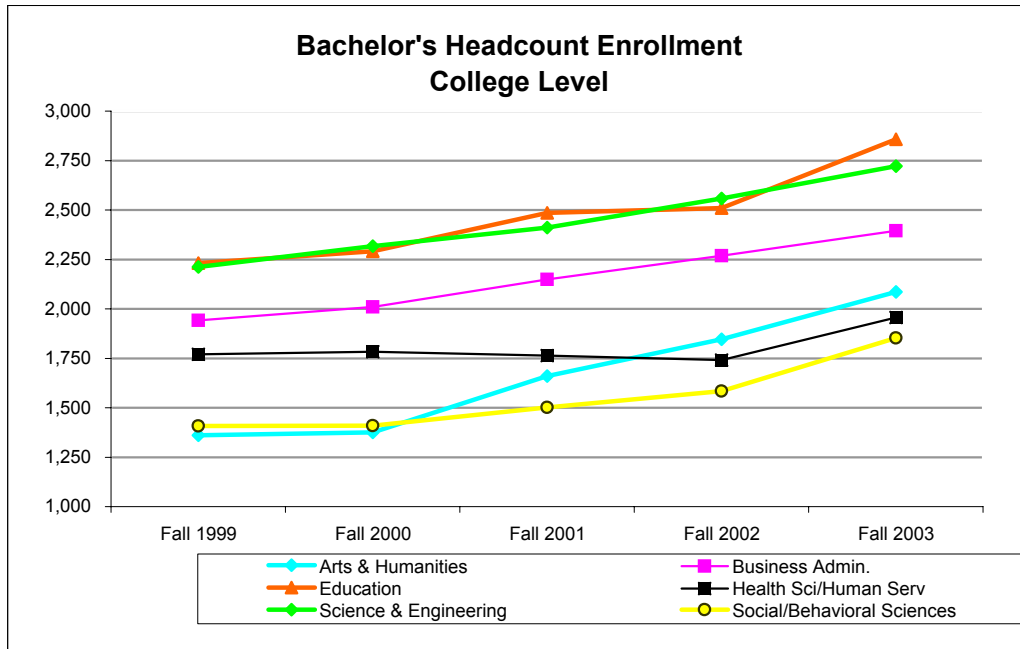
