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HIGHLIGHTS

The comparisons shown in this report are from Fall 2003 to Fall 2007.

University Level

- **Enrollment** – UTPA continues to grow steadily showing a 10% increase in the past 5 years from 15,915 to 17,435 students.
- **Semester Credit Hours (SCH)** – Semester credit hours continue to increase at all degree levels with an increase of 14% over 5 years.
- **Retention** – First-year retention has increased at the undergraduate level in the past 5 years from 66.8% to 68.4%.
- **Degrees Awarded** – The number of degrees awarded at the Bachelor's and Master's level continues to increase. In the last 5 years, Bachelor's degrees awarded went up by 47% and Master's degrees awarded went up by 60%. Attention needs to be paid to doctoral degrees awarded in order for UTPA to meet its goal of becoming classified as a Doctoral/Research University.

College Level

➤ College of Arts & Humanities

▪ Bachelor's

- **Enrollment** – The enrollment in the College of Arts and Humanities continues to increase. It is at 2,377, an 11% increase since Fall 2003.
- **SCH** – College of Arts and Humanities continues to have the highest SCH among the 6 colleges. English department has the highest number of SCH, followed by History & Philosophy.
- **Retention** – Overall decrease of 2 points in the last 5 years. The rates for Art, Communication, Modern Languages and Music have contributed to this decrease.
- **Degrees Awarded** – Overall large increase in degrees awarded except in the area of Latin American Studies.

▪ Master's

- **Enrollment** – English and Modern Languages departments have the highest enrollment. Enrollment in English has increased by 127% and enrollment in Modern Languages has increased by 85%.
- **SCH** – College of Arts and Humanities has the largest increase in SCH (from 805 to 1,612, a 100% increase). Most of the departments in this college continue to grow with Music seeing the largest percentage increase in SCH (213%).
- **Degrees Awarded** – Modern Languages department has increased 175% from 4 to 11 degrees awarded. The only departments with a decrease in degrees awarded in the past 5 years are Art and Communication.

➤ **College of Business Administration**

▪ **Bachelor's**

- **Enrollment** – There has been an overall increase in enrollment. Quantitative Methods/IS is the only department showing a continuous decline in enrollment in the past 5 years. The department of Management, Marketing and International Business has the highest enrollment and has shown the highest increase in the past 5 years from 1,306 to 1,553 students (a 19% increase).
- **SCH** – Increase in all departments, except for Quantitative Methods/IS, with Accounting and Business Law showing the largest increase (32%).
- **Retention** – Overall retention has gone down by 0.8 points.
- **Degrees Awarded** – Overall increase of 74%.

▪ **Master's**

- **Enrollment** – Enrollment in the Master's program has increased from 206 in Fall 2003 to 288 in Fall 2007 (a 40% increase).
- **SCH** – Accounting and Business Law has the largest increase (206%).
- **Degrees Awarded** – There is an overall increase of 63% in degrees awarded in the past 5 years.

▪ **Doctoral**

- **Enrollment** – Continued increase in enrollment from 47 students in Fall 2003 to 63 students in Fall 2007.
- **SCH** – increase of 42% from 306 SCH in 2003 to 435 SCH in 2007.
- **Degrees Awarded** – The number of degrees awarded in this category is still low. More attention needs to be paid to this area.

➤ **College of Education**

▪ **Bachelor's**

- **Enrollment** – Overall enrollment has had a decrease in the last 5 years from 2,849 students to 2,399 students (a 16% decrease).
- **SCH** – There was a 13% decrease in total SCH. Educational Psychology shows a decrease of 57% followed by Curriculum & Instruction with a 20% decrease.
- **Retention** – Overall decrease of 0.2 points.
- **Degrees Awarded** – Overall increase of 7% in the degrees awarded. Interdisciplinary Studies has the highest number of degrees awarded in the college and its total has increased 9% from 320 to 349 in the past five years.

▪ **Master's**

- **Enrollment** – Starting from Fall 2005 students are not being listed under Professional Improvement. Although the overall enrollment is negative (-21%) over the last 5 years, the college of Education has the largest master's student enrollment.
- **SCH** – A 4% increase in total SCH at the Master's level with a 37% decline in the area of Health and Kinesiology. SCH in the Department of Educational Leadership increased 22%.

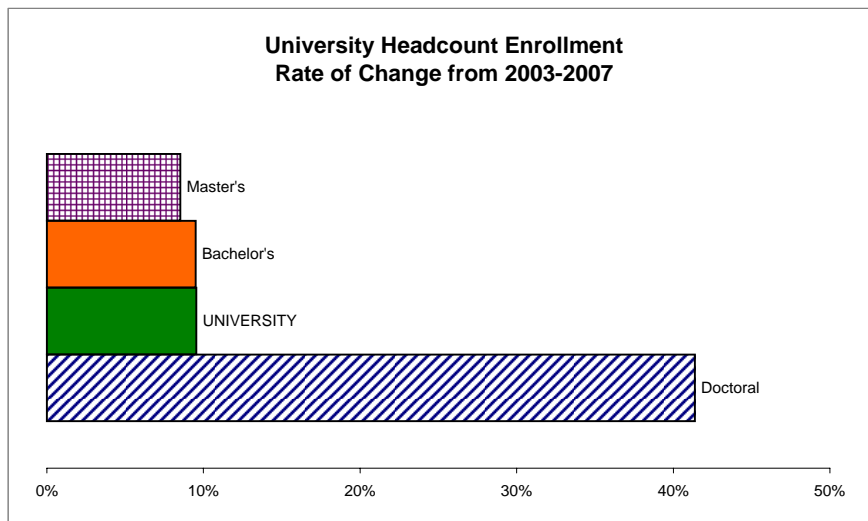
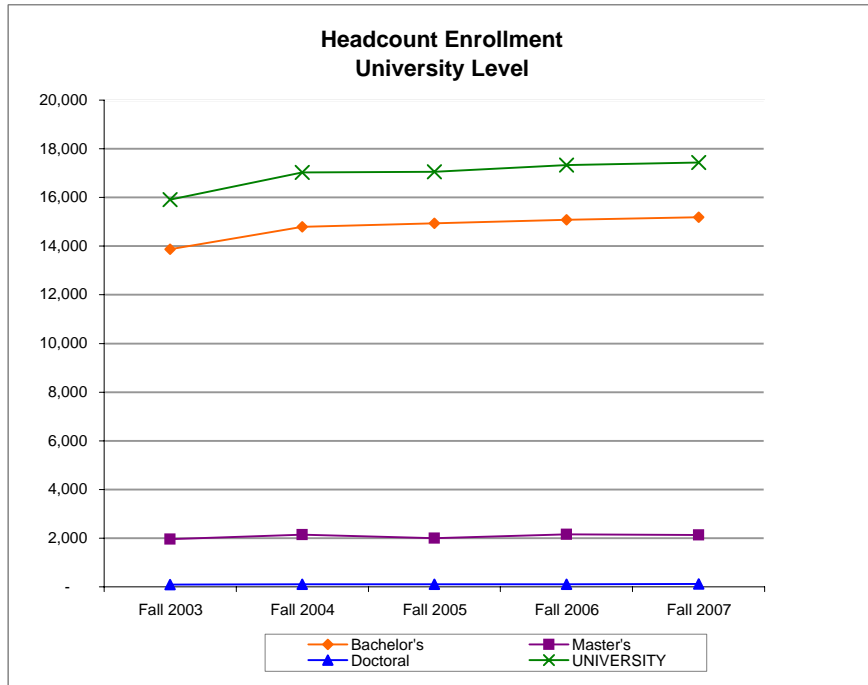
- **Degrees Awarded** – Overall increase of 67%.
 - **Doctoral**
 - **Enrollment** – A 50% increase from 40 students in 2003 to 60 students in 2007.
 - **SCH** – There has been no growth in SCH in the last 5 years.
 - **Degrees Awarded** – Overall increase of 100% from 3 in 2003 to 6 in 2007.
- **College of Health Sciences & Human Services**
- **Bachelor's**
 - **Enrollment** – The college of Health Sciences & Human Services has the largest enrollment increase, 31%. The highest enrollment is in the department of Nursing, followed by Communication Disorders. The Department of Rehabilitative Services has the largest increase from 100 students in Fall 2003 to 372 students in Fall 2007 (a 272% increase). There has been a significant decline in Occupational Therapy from 119 students in Fall 2003 to 6 students in Fall 2007 as this program is being phased out. The department of Physician Assistant has shown a decline in the past 5 years of 23%.
 - **SCH** – Rehabilitative Services has the highest SCH, followed by Communication Disorders. Occupational Therapy has declined from 675 SCH in 2003 to 0 SCH in 2007 as the Occupational Therapy program has been phased out.
 - **Retention** – Overall increase of 5.5 points.
 - **Degrees Awarded** – Overall increase of 23% with a decline of 14% in Social Work.
 - **Master's**
 - **Enrollment** – Overall increase in enrollment from 242 students in 2003 to 318 students in 2007 (a 31% increase). Greatest increase in enrollment has been in the departments of Occupational Therapy and Social Work.
 - **SCH** – Overall increase of 8%. Highest SCH is in the department of Social Work followed by Occupational Therapy.
 - **Degrees Awarded** – Overall increase of 52% with Rehabilitative Services showing an increase of 55% from 11 in 2003 to 17 in 2007.
- **College of Science & Engineering**
- **Bachelor's**
 - **Enrollment** – Pre-Engineering has shown an increase of 425% from 20 students in 2003 to 105 students in 2007.
 - **SCH** – Overall increase of 12%, but with a 6% decrease in the Electrical Engineering department. Highest number of SCH is in Mathematics followed by Biology.
 - **Retention** – Overall increase of 2.7 points.
 - **Degrees Awarded** – Overall increase of 41%.

- **Master's**
 - **Enrollment** – Enrollment has gone up from 206 students in Fall 2003 to 283 students in Fall 2007 (a 37% increase).
 - **SCH** – Greatest SCH in Computer Science, but the largest increases are in Chemistry, Mechanical Engineering and Mathematics.
 - **Degrees Awarded** – Overall increase of 83% in the last 5 years.

- **College of Social & Behavioral Sciences**
 - **Bachelor's**
 - **Enrollment** – Overall increase of 10%. Highest enrollment is in Criminal Justice followed by Psychology.
 - **SCH** – Overall increase of 32% from 20,128 to 26,625. Highest SCH in Political Science followed by Psychology. Anthropology has the largest increase of 48%.
 - **Retention** – Overall increase of 0.9 points.
 - **Degrees Awarded** – Overall increase of 82% in the last 5 years.
 - **Master's**
 - **Enrollment** – Overall enrollment has increased from 138 students in 2003 to 164 students in 2007 (a 19% increase) with Public Administration showing the highest percentage increase (26%).
 - **SCH** – A 10% overall increase in SCH from 927 in Fall 2003 to 1,023 in Fall 2007 with Criminal Justice showing the largest increase of 30%.
 - **Degrees Awarded** – Overall increase of 8% in the last 5 years.

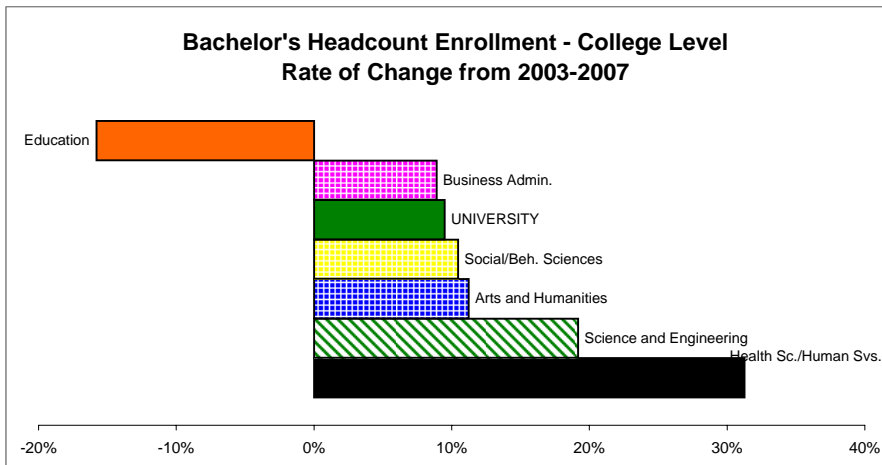
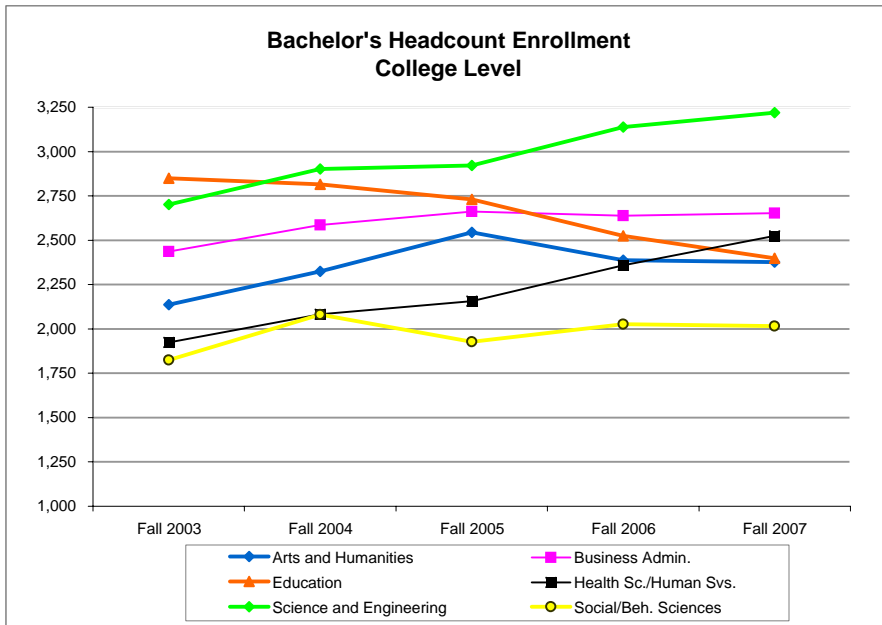
