HIGHLIGHTS

The comparisons shown in this report are from Spring 2004 to Spring 2008.

University Level

- **Enrollment** – UTPA continues to grow showing an 8% increase in the past 5 years from 15,157 to 16,303 students.
- **Semester Credit Hours (SCH)** – Semester credit hours continue to increase at all degree levels from 11% to 23%. Overall there has been an increase of 11% on the semester credit hours from Spring 2004 to Spring 2008.

College Level

- **College of Arts & Humanities**
 - **Bachelor's**
 - **Enrollment** – Overall enrollment at 2,301 students in Spring 2008 has increased 7% in the last 5 years. Philosophy has increased from 25 to 45 students showing an 80% increase. There is a significant decrease of 79% in Professional Improvement/Undeclared from Spring 2004 (411 students) to Spring 2008 (87 students).
 - **SCH** – Overall SCH at 53,332 in Spring 2008 has increased 7% in the past 5 years. English with the highest SCH (16,839) has an increase of 7% and Communication with 6,752 SCH has the highest increase of 29% from Spring 2004 to Spring 2008.
 - **Master's**
 - **Enrollment** – Overall enrollment at 269 students has increased 59% in the last 5 years. Music has the highest rate of change (240%) from 4 to 17 students in the past 5 years. English, with 102 students, has the 2nd largest increase (137%) from Spring 2004 to Spring 2008. Communication, with 29 students, is the only department with a decrease at -17% in the past 5 years.
 - **SCH** – Overall SCH at 1,651 has increased 72% in the past 5 years. Music, for the past 5 years, has consistently increased their SCH and currently has the highest rate of change at 289%. English with 609 SCH (2008) showed a considerable jump from the previous year of 483 SCH (2006). It has maintained the highest SCH for the past 5 years.
- **College of Business Administration**
 - **Bachelor's**
 - **Enrollment** – Overall enrollment at 2,442 has increased 5% in the last 5 years. Quantitative Methods/IS and Professional Improvement/Undeclared show a decline of -39% and -35%, respectively. The department of Management, Marketing and International Business for Spring 2008 has the highest enrollment with 1,395 students showing an increase of 11% in the past 5 years. The department of Economics/Finance has shown the highest percentage increase in the past 5 years from 290 students in Spring 2004 to 354 students in Spring 2008 (a 22% increase).

- **SCH** – Overall SCH at 20,790 has increased 3% in the last 5 years. The department of Economics/Finance (37%) has the highest rate of change. The only department showing a decrease is Quantitative Methods/IS at -30%.
- **Master's**
 - **Enrollment** – Overall enrollment at 241 has increased 19% in the last 5 years. Management/Marketing/International Business has the highest enrollment of 198 students with a 49% increase. Accounting/Business Law has grown to an enrollment of 43 students in 5 years.
 - **SCH** – Overall SCH at 1,359 has increased 40% in the last 5 years. Management/Marketing/International Business has the highest SCH of 663 with a 5-year increase of 38%. Accounting/Business Law has the 2nd largest SCH (423) in Spring 2008 with a 5-year increase of 281%. The department of Quantitative Methods/IS shows a decrease of 18%.
- **Doctoral**
 - **Enrollment** – Overall enrollment at 60 has increased 40% in the last 5 years with a continued increase in enrollment from 43 students in Spring 2004 to 60 students in Spring 2008.
 - **SCH** – Overall SCH at 366 has increased 21% in the last 5 years. Economics/Finance has the largest increase of 144% from 48 SCH to 117 SCH as well as the largest SCH total.
- **College of Education**
 - **Bachelor's**
 - **Enrollment** – Overall enrollment at 2,162 has decreased 19% in the last 5 years. All departments show a negative rate of change. Curriculum and Instruction maintains the highest enrollment with 1,470 students in Spring 2008.
 - **SCH** – Overall SCH at 13,082 has decreased 19% in the last 5 years. Educational Psychology has had a steady SCH decline (-68%) for the last 5 years. Health and Kinesiology is the only department that shows a slight increase of 1%.
 - **Master's**
 - **Enrollment** – Overall enrollment at 962 has decreased 4% in the last 5 years. The department of Educational Leadership shows the largest increase in the College in the last 5 years from 251 students in Spring 2004 to 368 students in Spring 2008 (a 47% increase). Curriculum & Instruction shows a 5-year decrease of 9%.
 - **SCH** – Overall SCH at 5,048 has increased 2% in the last 5 years. Educational Leadership has increased 18% with 2,175 SCH in the past five years.
 - **Doctoral**
 - **Enrollment** – Overall enrollment at 62 has increased 63% in the last 5 years. Enrollment for Educational Leadership went up from 47 students (Spring 2007) to 62 students (Spring 2008).

- **SCH** – Overall SCH at 252 has increased 27% in the last 5 years. SCH in Educational Leadership went up from 191 (Spring 2007) to 252 (Spring 2008).
- **College of Health Sciences & Human Services**
 - **Bachelor's**
 - **Enrollment** – Overall enrollment at 2,350 has increased 32% in the last 5 years. The highest enrollment for Spring 2008 is in the department of Nursing Education (897 students), followed by Communication Disorders (407 students). Rehabilitation Services has the highest increase of 245%. The departments of Physician Assistant and Occupational Therapy (no longer offered as a major as of Spring 2008) have shown declines in the past 5 years of 27% and 89%, respectively.
 - **SCH** – Overall SCH at 12,320 has increased 33% in the last 5 years. Rehabilitation Services (3,408) has the highest SCH, followed by Nursing (2,439). Rehabilitation Services has the largest increase of 238% from Spring 2004 to Spring 2008. Social Work shows a decline rate of 4%.
 - **Master's**
 - **Enrollment** – Overall enrollment at 299 has increased 22% in the last 5 years. Occupational Therapy has grown to 45 students in 4 years, from 2005 to 2008. Social Work with the highest enrollment (83 students) has the highest 5-year increase of 144%. Communication Disorders has a decrease of 49% in five years.
 - **SCH** – Overall SCH at 2,419 has increased 3% in the last 5 years. Occupational Therapy has the greatest 4-year (Spring 2005 to Spring 2008) increase of 115%. Social work has the greatest 5-year increase of 58%. Social Work (747) has the highest SCH followed by Occupational Therapy (491). Communication Disorders with 295 SCH has a decreased rate of 75%.
- **College of Science & Engineering**
 - **Bachelor's**
 - **Enrollment** – Overall enrollment at 2,872 has increased 18% in the last 5 years. Biology has the highest enrollment of 1,269 with an increase of 33%. Biology has maintained the highest enrollment for the last 5 years over all other departments. Pre-Engineering has the largest increase of 717% from 12 to 98. Mechanical Engineering has the 2nd highest enrollment (477) and 2nd greatest increase (46%) and has steadily increased enrollment every Spring since 2004. Five departments with declining enrollment: Mathematics (-8%), Professional Improvement/Undeclared (-55%), Computer Science (-6%), Manufacturing (-29%) and Electrical (-11%).
 - **SCH** – Overall SCH at 40,156 has increased 12% in the last 5 years. Highest number of SCH are in Mathematics (12,570) followed by Biology (10,949). Manufacturing Engineering has the largest increase of 43%. Computer Science (1,992) shows a decrease in SCH at -9%.
 - **Master's**
 - **Enrollment** – Overall enrollment at 240 has increased 22% in the last 5 years. Mechanical, with 44 students, has the greatest rate increase of 159%.

Computer Science, with a 23% decrease, has maintained the highest enrollment for the last 5 years. Computer Science (-23%) and Manufacturing (-34%) are both showing a decrease from Spring 2004 to Spring 2008.

- **SCH** – Overall SCH at 1,615 has increased 31% in the last 5 years. The highest SCH is in Computer Science (348), but the greatest increase is in Mechanical (171%) - not including Chemistry shows an increase to 70 SCH (which decreased from 141 SCH in Spring 2007).

- **College of Social & Behavioral Sciences**

- **Bachelor's**

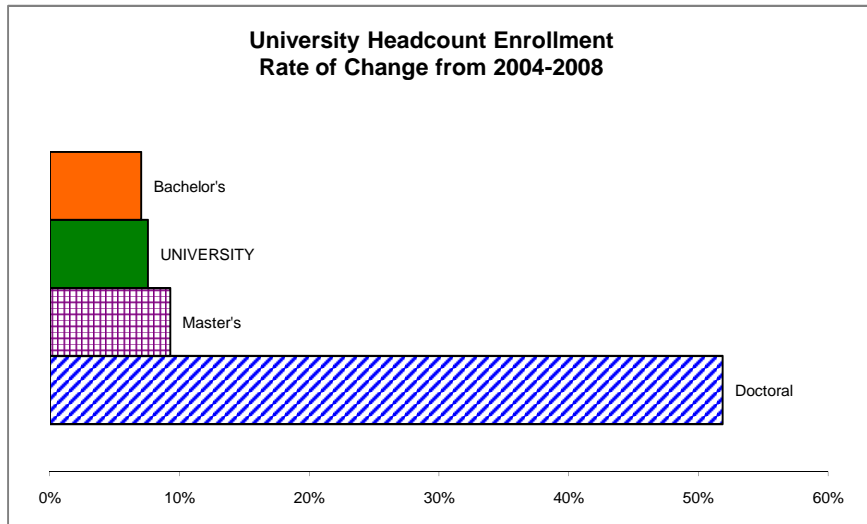
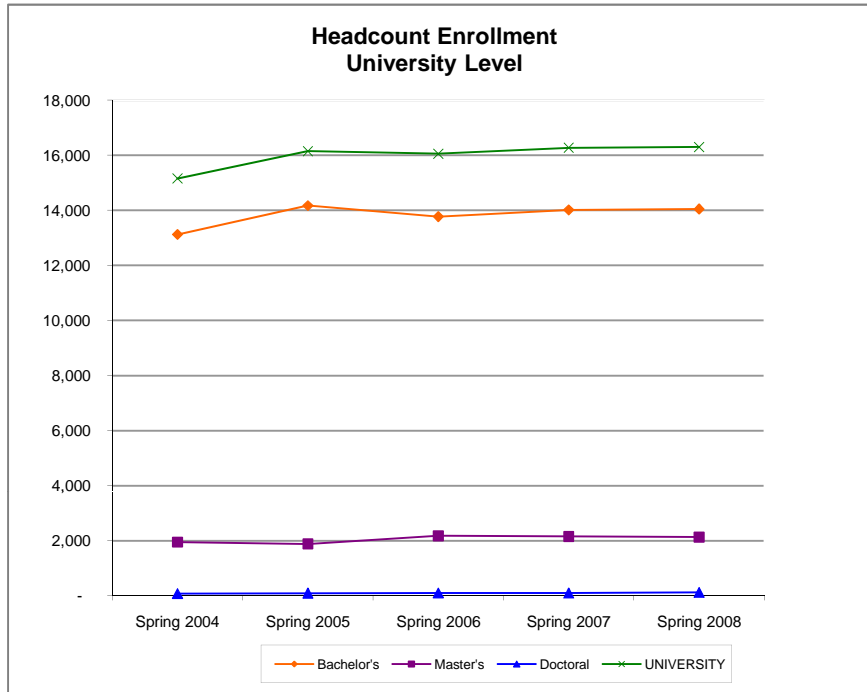
- **Enrollment** – Overall enrollment at 1,919 has increased 9% in the last 5 years. The greatest increase is in the department of SOSB (Interdisciplinary Studies) from 50 students in Spring 2004 to 131 students in Spring 2008 (a 162% increase). The highest enrollment is in Criminal Justice (741) followed by Psychology (640).
 - **SCH** – Overall SCH at 25,639 has increased 28% in the last 5 years. The greatest increase of 46% is in Psychology/Anthropology from 6,344 SCH in Spring 2004 to 9,269 SCH in Spring 2008. The highest SCH is in Psychology/Anthropology (9,269) followed by Political Science (8,379).

- **Master's**

- **Enrollment** – Overall enrollment at 124 has decreased 10% in the last 5 years. Sociology has shown no increase in enrollment for the past 5 years. Highest enrollment is in Psychology with 40 students and a rate decrease of 20%. Public Administration has the 2nd highest enrollment with 37 students and a decrease of 3%.
 - **SCH** – Overall SCH at 894 has decreased 2% in the last 5 years. Criminal Justice has the highest increase of 11%. Psychology/Anthropology has the highest SCH (417) with a decrease of 1%.

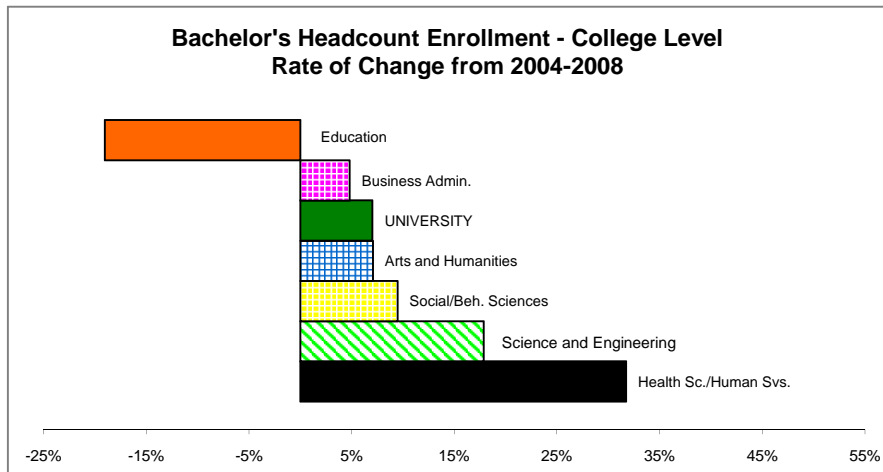
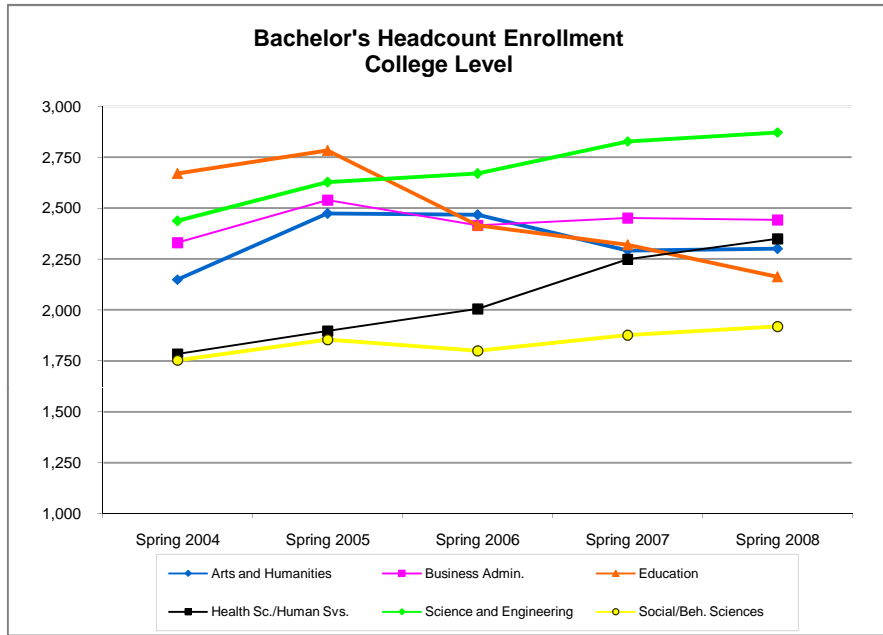
