HIGHLIGHTS

The comparisons shown in this report are from Summer 2000 to Summer 2004.

University Level

- **Enrollment** – UTPA continues to grow at a fast pace showing a 31% increase in the past 5 years from 7,892 to 10,353 students.
- **Semester Credit Hours (SCH)** – Semester credit hours continue to increase at all degree levels.

College Level

- **College of Arts & Humanities**
 - **Bachelor's**
 - **Enrollment** – Of the 6 colleges, the College of Arts and Humanities had the largest increase in enrollment. The only department of concern in this College is Latin American Studies with single digit enrollment.
 - **SCH** – English department has the highest number of SCH, followed by History & Philosophy.
 - **Master's**
 - **Enrollment** – Enrollment in the Master's program has decreased from 67 students in 2000 to 62 students in 2004 (a 7% decrease). English has the highest enrollment, followed by History & Philosophy and Communications. Modern Languages has shown a 75% decrease in the last 5 years from 16 in Summer 2000 to 4 in Summer 2004. History & Philosophy has increased from 2 students in Summer 2000 to 14 students in Summer 2004 (a 600% increase).
 - **SCH** – Most of the departments in this college continue to grow with History & Philosophy seeing the largest percent increase in SCH. Modern Languages and Communications show decreases in the last 5 years of 95% and 34%, respectively.
- **College of Business Administration**
 - **Bachelor's**
 - **Enrollment** – There has been an overall increase in enrollment. Accounting/Business Law shows a slight decrease in enrollment from 278 in Summer 2000 to 260 in Summer 2004. The department of Management, Marketing and International Business has the highest enrollment.
 - **SCH** – Increase in all departments.
 - **Master's**
 - **Enrollment** – Enrollment in the Master's program has decreased from 157 in Summer 2000 to 142 in Summer 2004 (a 10% decrease).
 - **SCH** – COBA is the only college to have a decrease in SCH at the Master's level.

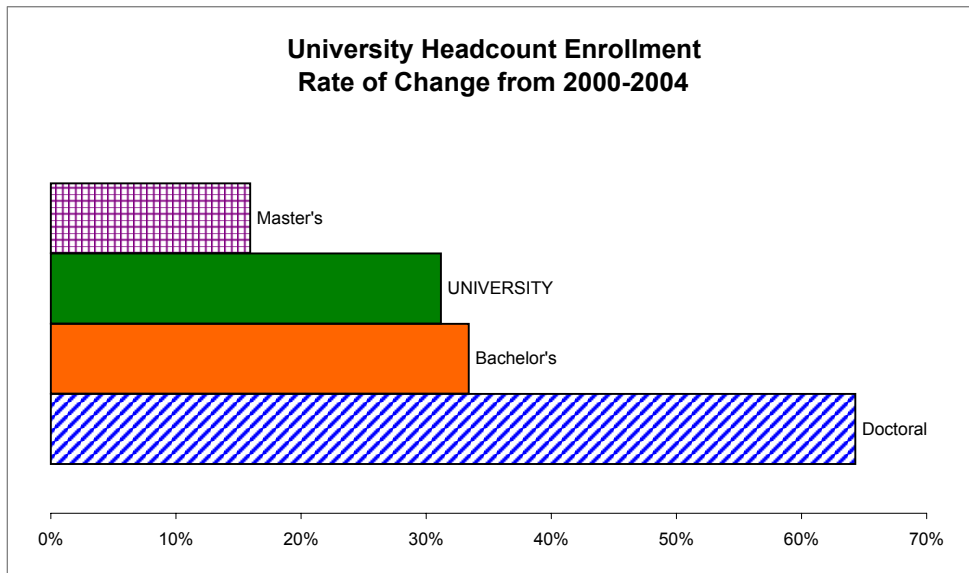
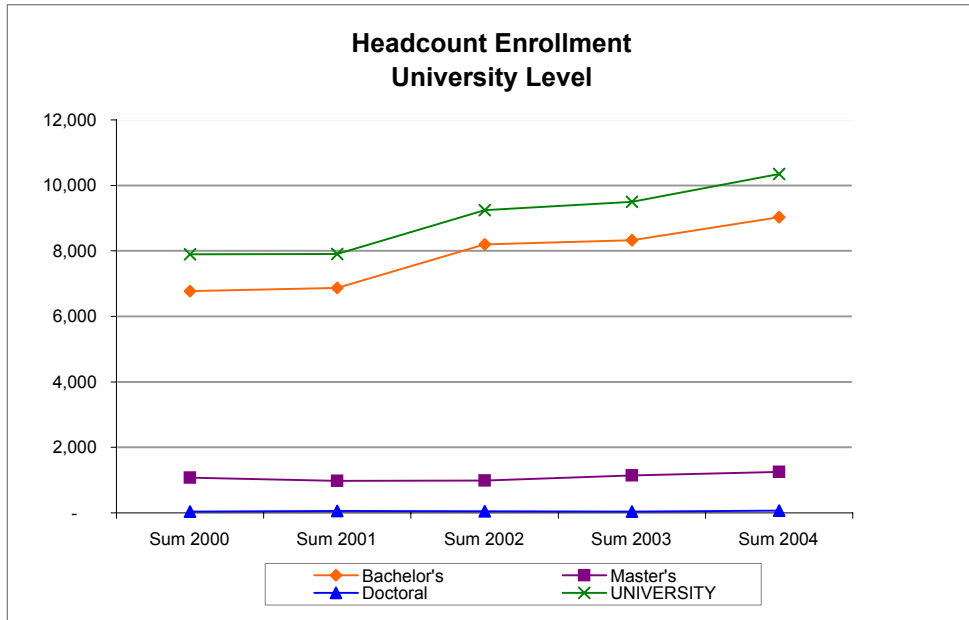
- **Doctoral**
 - **Enrollment** – Continued increase in enrollment from 22 students in Summer 2000 to 36 students in Summer 2004.
 - **SCH** – 25% increase from 48 SCH in Summer 2000 to 60 SCH in Summer 2004.
- **College of Education**
 - **Bachelor's**
 - **Enrollment** – The number of undeclared majors is very great. Overall enrollment in the college increased from 1,538 students in Summer 2000 to 1,739 students in Summer 2004 (a 13% increase).
 - **SCH** – There was an 8% increase in total SCH. SCH decreased slightly in the past 5 years in Educational Psychology and Health & Kinesiology.
 - **Master's**
 - **Enrollment** – Educational Psychology has the highest enrollment followed by Educational Leadership.
 - **SCH** – A 15% increase in total SCH. Educational Leadership increased from 1,098 SCH in Summer 2000 to 2,184 SCH in Summer 2004.
 - **Doctoral**
 - **Enrollment** – A 65% increase from 20 students in 2000 to 33 students in 2004.
 - **SCH** – SCH in Educational Leadership has grown from 158 SCH in Summer 2000 to 228 in Summer 2004 (a 44% increase).
- **College of Health Sciences & Human Services**
 - **Bachelor's**
 - **Enrollment** – College of Health Sciences & Human Services is the only college to have a decrease in enrollment over the past 5 years at the Bachelor's level. The highest enrollment is in the department of Nursing, followed by Communication Disorders and Social Work. There has been a significant decline in Occupational Therapy from 142 students in Summer 2000 to 37 students in Summer 2004 (a 74% decrease).
 - **SCH** – Overall decrease of 12% at Bachelor's level. Physician Asst. Program has the highest SCH, followed by Social Work.
 - **Master's**
 - **Enrollment** – Greatest increase in enrollment has been in the department of Communication Disorders.
 - **SCH** – Largest increase in SCH at Master's level in College of Health Sciences & Human services from 543 SCH in Summer 2000 to 1,553 SCH in Summer 2004 (a 186% increase). Highest SCH is in the department of Communication Disorders.

- **College of Science & Engineering**
 - **Bachelor's**
 - **Enrollment** – Undeclared majors are increasing in the college. Pre-Engineering is on the decline showing that more students in engineering have decided on their majors.
 - **SCH** – Highest number of SCH are in Mathematics.
 - **Master's**
 - **Enrollment** – Largest increase in Manufacturing Engineering. Decrease in Computer Science and Mechanical Engineering.
 - **SCH** – Greatest SCH in Mathematics.

- **College of Social & Behavioral Sciences**
 - **Bachelor's**
 - **Enrollment** – Highest enrollment is in Criminal Justice followed by Psychology/Anthropology.
 - **SCH** – Highest SCH is in Psychology/Anthropology followed by Political Science.
 - **Master's**
 - **Enrollment** – Highest enrollment is in Psychology/Anthropology followed by Political Science.
 - **SCH** – 58% increase in SCH from 180 in Summer 2000 to 285 in Summer 2004.

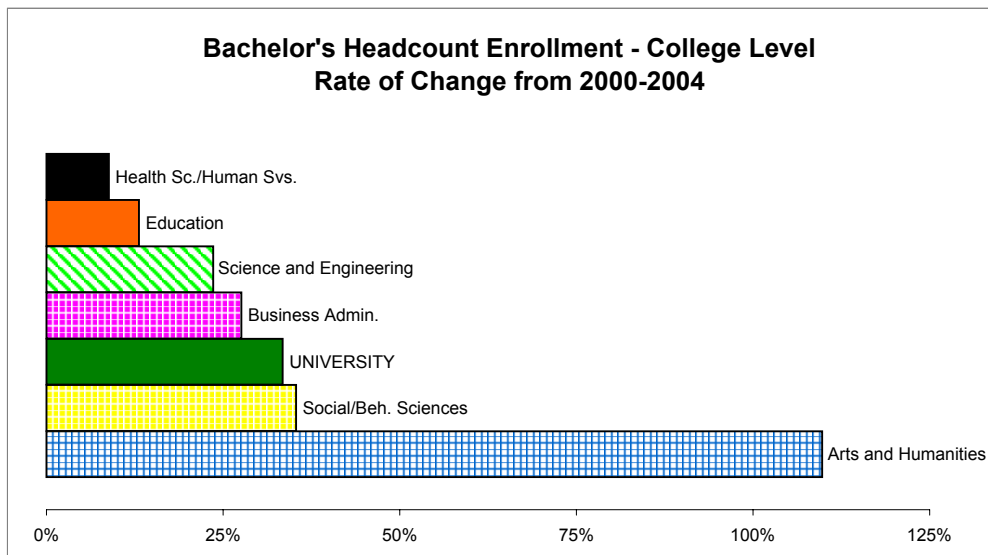
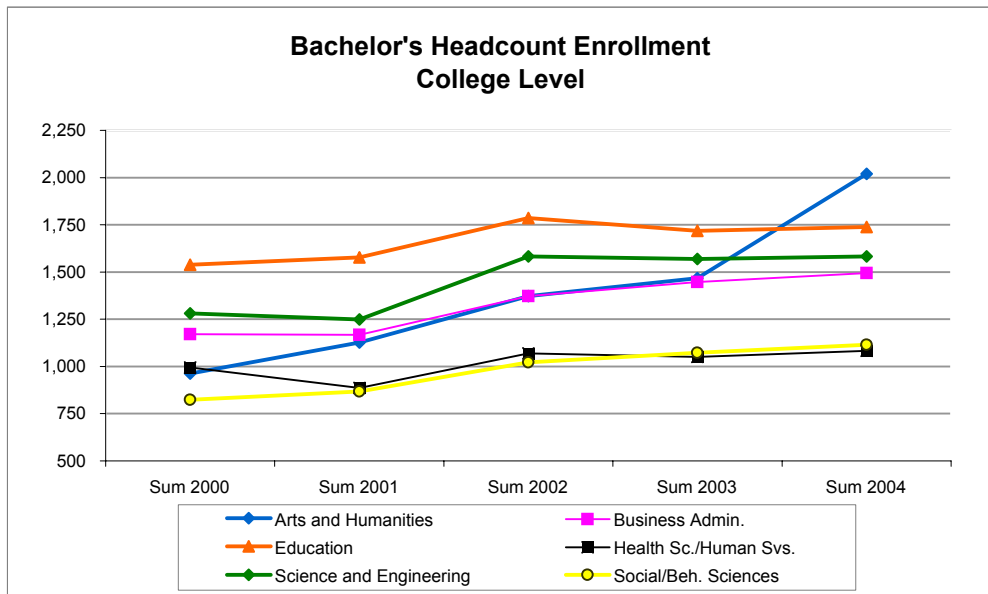
