HIGHLIGHTS

The comparisons shown in this report are from Summer 2001 to Summer 2005.

University Level

- **Enrollment** – UTPA continues to grow at a fast pace showing a 38% increase in the past 5 years from 7,907 to 10,877 students.
- **Semester Credit Hours (SCH)** – Semester credit hours continue to increase at all degree levels.

College Level

- **College of Arts & Humanities**
 - **Bachelor's**
 - **Enrollment** – Of the 6 colleges, the College of Arts and Humanities had the largest increase in enrollment. The only department of concern in this College is Latin American Studies with single digit enrollment.
 - **SCH** – English department has the highest number of SCH, followed by History and Philosophy.
 - **Master's**
 - **Enrollment** – Enrollment in the Master's program has increased from 52 students in 2001 to 72 students in 2005 (a 38% increase). English has the highest enrollment, followed by Modern Languages, and Communications.
 - **SCH** – Most of the departments in this college continue to decline except for English department and History & Philosophy department.
- **College of Business Administration**
 - **Bachelor's**
 - **Enrollment** – There has been an overall increase in enrollment. The department of Management, Marketing and International Business has the highest enrollment.
 - **SCH** – Increase in all departments.
 - **Master's**
 - **Enrollment** – Enrollment in the Master's program has decreased from 113 in Summer 2001 to 66 in Summer 2005 (a 42% decrease).
 - **SCH** – COBA is the only college to have a decrease in SCH at the Master's level.
 - **Doctoral**
 - **Enrollment** – Continued increase in enrollment from 22 students in Summer 2001 to 31 students in Summer 2005 (a 41% increase).
 - **SCH** – 22% decrease from 54 SCH in Summer 2001 to 42 SCH in Summer 2005.

- **College of Education**
 - **Bachelor's**
 - **Enrollment** – Overall enrollment in the college increased from 1,578 students in Summer 2001 to 1,744 students in Summer 2005 (an 11% increase).
 - **SCH** – There was a 14% decrease in total SCH. In the past 5 years, SCH decreased in Educational Psychology and in Curriculum and Instruction.
 - **Master's**
 - **Enrollment** – Educational Psychology has the highest enrollment followed by Educational Leadership.
 - **SCH** – A 26% increase in total SCH. Educational Leadership increased from 870 SCH in Summer 2001 to 1,644 SCH in Summer 2005.
 - **Doctoral**
 - **Enrollment** – A 3% increase from 35 students in 2001 to 36 students in 2005.
 - **SCH** – SCH in Educational Leadership has grown from 183 SCH in Summer 2001 to 271 in Summer 2005 (a 48% increase).

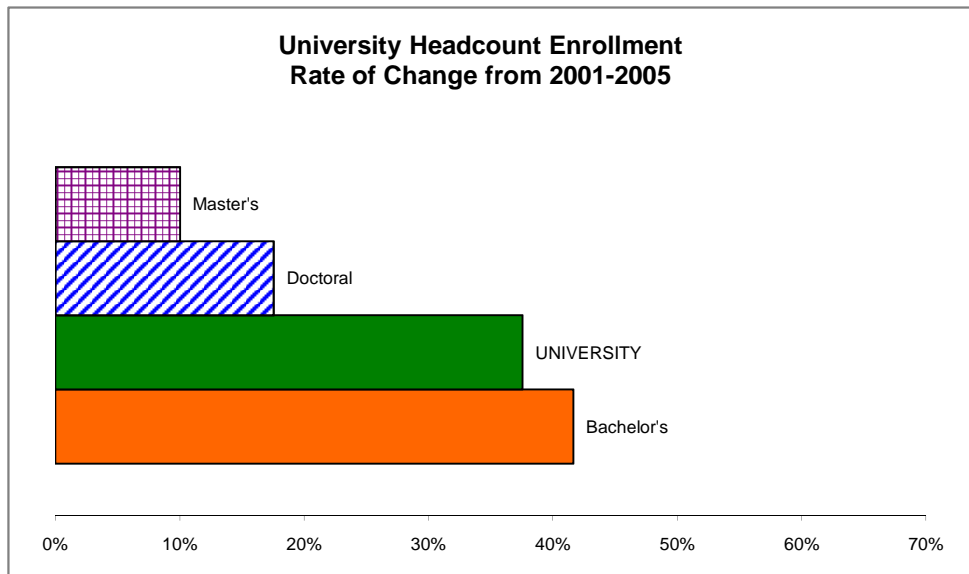
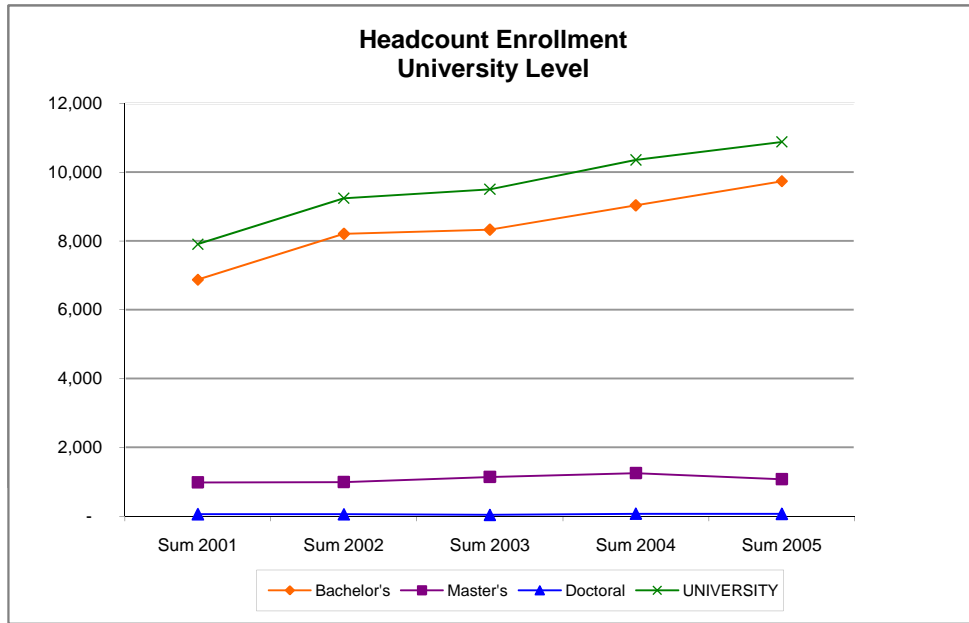
- **College of Health Sciences & Human Services**
 - **Bachelor's**
 - **Enrollment** – The highest enrollment is in the department of Nursing, followed by Communication Disorders.
 - **SCH** – Overall increase of 14% at Bachelor's level. Physician Assistant Program has the highest SCH, followed by Social Work.
 - **Master's**
 - **Enrollment** – Greatest increase in enrollment has been in the department of Communication Disorders (from 16 students in Summer 2001 to 58 students in Summer 2005).
 - **SCH** – SCH increased from 675 SCH in Summer 2001 to 1,402 SCH in Summer 2005 (a 108% increase). Highest SCH is in the department of Communication Disorders.

- **College of Science & Engineering**
 - **Bachelor's**
 - **Enrollment** – There was a 38% increase in enrollment in the last 5 years.
 - **SCH** – Highest SCH is in Mathematics.
 - **Master's**
 - **Enrollment** – Largest increase in Manufacturing Engineering. Decrease in Computer Science, Professional Improvement, and Mechanical Engineering.
 - **SCH** – Highest SCH is in Mathematics.

- **College of Social & Behavioral Sciences**
 - **Bachelor's**
 - **Enrollment** – Highest enrollment is in Criminal Justice followed by Psychology/Anthropology.
 - **SCH** – Highest SCH is in Political Science followed by Psychology/Anthropology.
 - **Master's**
 - **Enrollment** – Highest enrollment is in Public Administration followed by Psychology/Anthropology.
 - **SCH** – 17% increase in SCH from 189 in Summer 2001 to 222 in Summer 2005.

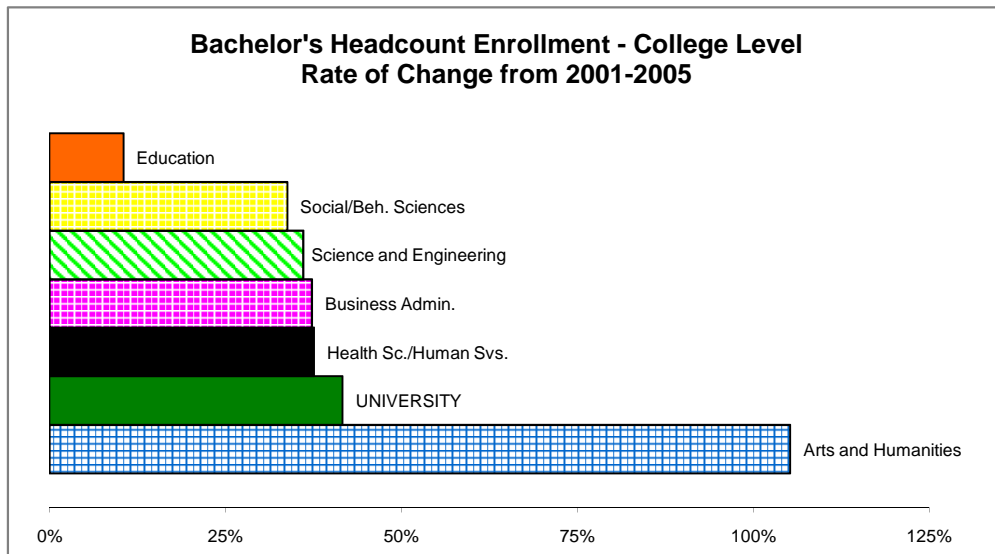
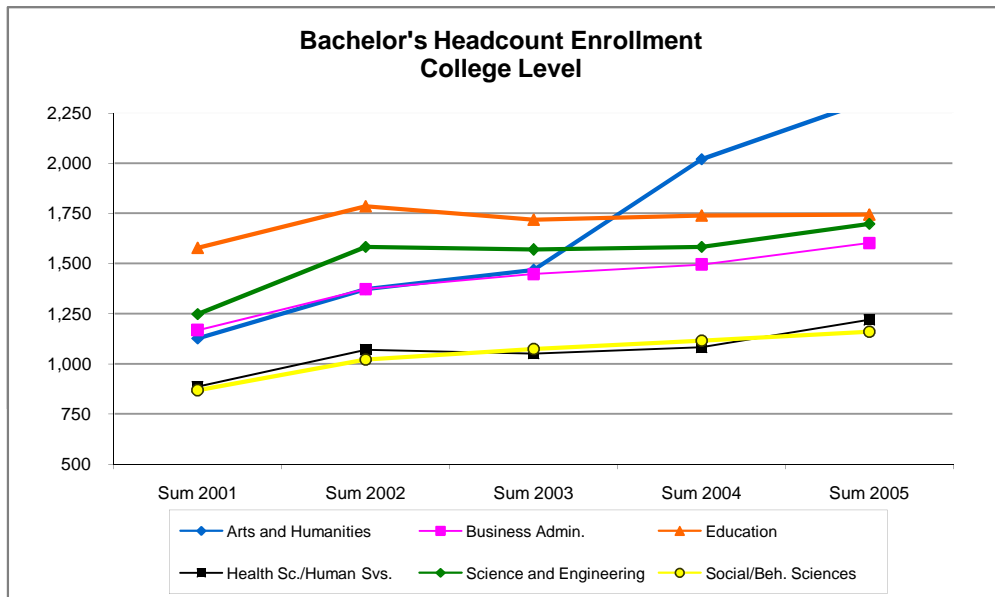
